Susan Bogart, husband Cato, d. July 20, 1882

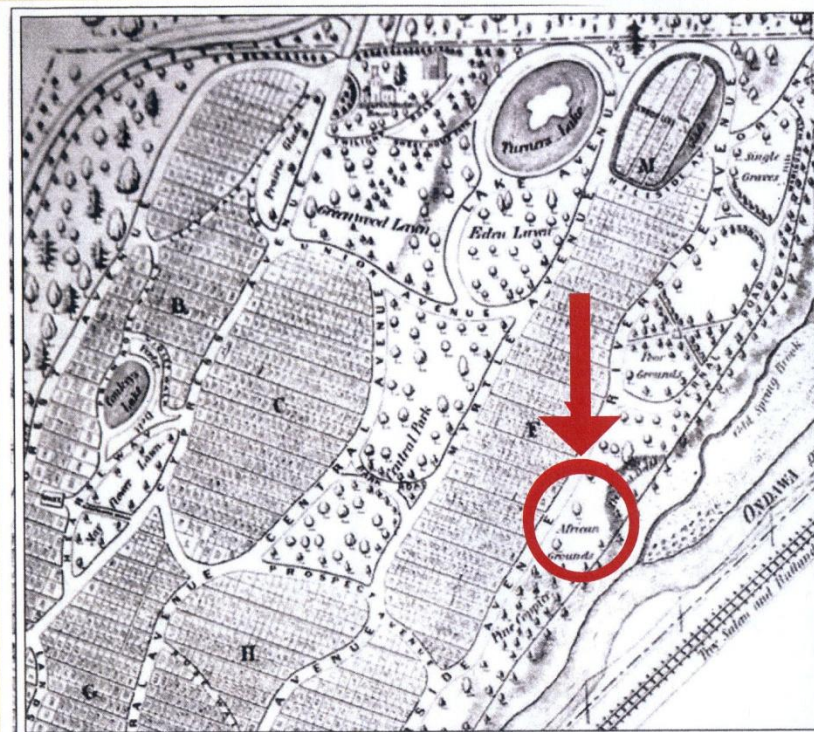
Cato Bogart, wife Susan, d. Feb. 21 1877, age 74

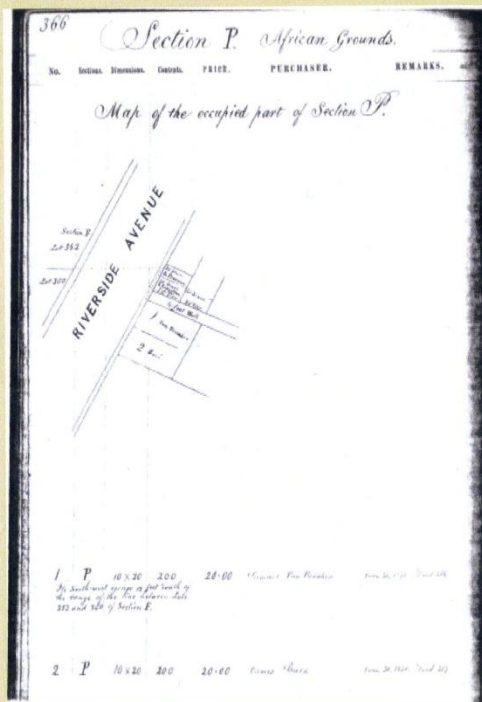
